



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TRAINEES

The aim of this code is to enable all trainees to flourish, feel happy and safe and achieve their full potential in a caring environment. We understand that certain trainees, in their home environment, may be able to behave differently, but on a training camp run by Precise Racing it is important for the well-being of all concerned that all trainees adhere to the same Code of Conduct.

1. Trainees of all ages and at all times are not permitted to smoke tobacco, consume alcohol or use any recreational or performance enhancing drugs.
2. Medicinal drugs may only be taken with the full knowledge of Precise Racing staff (if trainees are under the age of 18).
3. Trainees are not allowed to engage in any sexual activity of any kind.
4. Trainees must not behave in a discriminatory manner.
5. Trainees must observe Health & Safety rules and the FIS Skier's Code.
6. Trainees must follow instructions from any Precise Racing member of staff.
7. Trainees shall conduct themselves with good manners at all times and bad language will not be tolerated.
8. Precise will not tolerate bullying of any kind. Trainees should be (at the very least) respectful of their fellow competitors and teammates. All Precise trainees have a responsibility to ensure that they are fair and considerate to one another.
9. Minor cases (misconduct) will be dealt with in-house through verbal reminders & written warnings. In repeat or more severe cases (Gross Misconduct), the relevant parent(s) will be contacted immediately & trainee's may be removed from the camp with immediate effect at the trainees' own expense. In this scenario no refunds will be issued.
