Aldershot provide a stocked first aid kit, with stock agreed to Active Nation standards for use by first aiders who are on duty at the event. 3. No medication is carried. 4. Officials instructed to summon first aid help if it is required, race to be stopped. 5. First Aider to assess whether injured can be moved from slope or not. 6 If can be moved, slope is cleared, and race restarted. 7. If must be left in situ then race will continue to be suspended until appropriate next level support (ambulance) attends and course is cleared. 8. First Aiders / Race Officials call Aldershot Duty Manager who is then responsible for the incident and will call Ambulance if required 9. Back up first aider called to replace first aider if attending the incident 10. TD completes accident form on notes on report.
