



Surrey Schools' Ski Championships 2026 Invitation Bulletin

Venue: Aldershot Ski Slope, Gallwey Road, Aldershot GU11 2DD

Date: Sunday 15th November 2026

The Surrey Schools Ski Championships is open exclusively to students attending schools located within Surrey, including those that were part of Surrey prior to the 1965 boundary changes. The event will include a two-run slalom race on the same course, followed by a thrilling dual slalom team knockout competition. Competitors may enter either as individuals or as part of a school team made up of three or four racers. Racers must be in school years 1 to 13, and entries will be accepted until the maximum of 250 competitors is reached. The morning will be dedicated to Primary School skiers (Y1–6), with Secondary School racers (Y7–13) competing in the afternoon. For a more detailed breakdown of the schedule, please refer to the provisional programme below.

Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Schools are welcome to enter multiple teams; however, all team members must attend the same school. It is the responsibility of the school to ensure that all entrants are competent and confident skiing a slalom course.

Dual Slalom Knockout (Updated Format from 2026)

From 2026 onwards, the dual slalom event will move from a team relay format to an individual head-to-head knockout competition. Racers will continue to compete side by side on parallel courses, with separate male and female categories.

All racers who have completed the slalom will be eligible to take part. The knockout will run on a simple win-and-advance basis. Racers will start in a completely random order, determined by the start marshals at the top. If a racer wins their run, they return to the top of the slope and continue in the competition. If they lose, they are eliminated.

This format will steadily narrow the field to the fastest competitors, with the top three male and top three female racers receiving awards.

Please note that there will be no predetermined structure or seeding for match-ups; all pairings will be randomly selected by the start marshal to keep the event fast-moving and exciting.

How to Enter

All school teams and individual competitors must submit their entries via the following link: **Enter Here**

Once your entry is submitted, you will receive details on how to make payment.

Important Notes:

- Late entry fees may apply.
- No competitor will be allowed to race unless full payment has been received **before** race day.

- If you are entering as part of a team, you are automatically entered into the individual competition—**only one entry fee per racer** is required.

Individual fee: £26.00

Officials

We would very much appreciate if each team can provide a volunteer to officiate and help run the race. Please note experience is not necessary. Once officials attend the team managers meeting, they will gain an understanding of their role.

Race Rules

- Teams must race in the year group of the eldest member
- Skiers will race in number order for both runs
- The individual championship will be decided by the fastest time out of the two runs
- The team championship will be decided by the aggregate of the best three times for each run added together to give the overall team time
- Racers that are disqualified, or did not complete the first run **will** be allowed to take part in the second run
- If racers do not submit a time for either of their slalom race runs, they **will** still be eligible to compete in the dual knockout event
- To compete in the dual knock-out event, racers must have competed in the slalom race
- Racers are expected to behave in a sporting manner towards other competitors and race officials. Racers may be disqualified if they fail to adhere to slope rules or behave in an unsporting manner.

Bibs Collection

Bibs will be issued to the school's team manager. Upon bib collection you must tell the organisers if your entire team wish to compete in the dual knockout event in the afternoon.

Any changes to racer's names must be confirmed to the race office prior to collecting bibs. Any damaged or lost bibs will result in a £80 charge, per bib.

First Aid

Will be provided by Aldershot Ski Centre.

Team managers should ensure they carry out their own medical consent forms.

Course Inspection

The course must be inspected wearing skis, helmets, gloves and bibs. No one is allowed to ski the course during inspection, with exception of those taking part in the 'Rabbit Run'. Race officials/coaches may accompany their racers providing they notify the race office.

For those Primary School skiers who have never raced before, a 'Rabbit Run' will be arranged where they will be led through the course by an experienced skier to ensure they understand the course layout just before the race begins.

Regulations

Helmets, long sleeves, long trousers, and gloves are compulsory for all racers whilst they are on the ski slope. Bibs should be worn with numbers visible for the duration of the racing and must be handed to the Finish Marshall at the end of the dual knockout or 2nd run if racers are not taking part in the dual knockout. Failure to do so will result in a charge of £80 for each missing bib. All equipment borrowed from the ski centre must be returned before prize giving.

Protests

Any protest must be made to the race office, accompanied by a representative if under the age of 18. To put in a protest, it comes at a fee of £20.00. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld. Protests will be considered by the Jury and the jury's decision will be final.
