



UK RACE EVENTS

When you book with Precise Racing, we want you to feel confident in the service you receive from the moment you sign up to the moment your racer completes their last run. These Terms & Conditions explain what you can expect from us and what we require from you to ensure a safe, fair and well-run event.

1. Booking

All race bookings must be made by parents, guardians, teachers or team managers directly with Precise Racing. Entry forms and race information are available at www.preciseracing.co.uk. For bookings or enquiries: emily@preciseracing.co.uk

2. Payments

Entries are only confirmed once full payment has been received by Precise Racing.

If payment is not received within 3 days of the competition, the entry may be declined, and the racer's place may be offered to another competitor.

3. Cancellations

3.1 Cancellations by Competitors

All cancellations must be sent by email to emily@preciseracing.co.uk

- A refund (minus a £5 administration fee) will be issued for cancellations received more than 3 days prior to the event.

- No refunds can be issued for cancellations made **within 3 days of the event**, regardless of reason (including illness or injury).

3.2 Cancellations by Precise Racing

If Precise Racing cancels an event, all entry fees will be refunded. No additional compensation will be provided.

3.3 Weather, Snow Conditions & Curtailment

If an event is affected by adverse weather, lack of snow, or operational issues at the facility (including, but not limited to, lift closure or slope malfunction), refunds will only be issued if Precise Racing receives a refund from the venue or service providers.

In the event of cancellation or curtailment for these reasons, Precise Racing is not liable for additional costs incurred by participants.

If the event must be relocated, additional fees imposed by the venue may be passed on to participants.

We strongly recommend all competitors obtain suitable cancellation insurance.

4. Health, Safety & Competence Requirements

It is the responsibility of the parent, guardian, teacher, or team manager entering a racer to ensure that:

- The competitor is competent and confident to ski a slalom course safely.
- The competitor can participate without posing risk to themselves or others.

There may be occasions where a child's medical, physical, or behavioural condition makes participation unsafe. Precise Racing reserves the right to exclude competitors on safety grounds.

Appropriate First Aid will be provided by qualified personnel. In the case of serious injury, emergency services may be contacted immediately and the school/parent/guardian informed.

4.1 Liability

Precise Racing does not accept liability for any injury, accident, damage or loss sustained during the event except where required by law.

Competitors take part at their own risk.

Parents, guardians, schools and team managers must ensure that appropriate personal accident and sports insurance is in place for every racer.

Precise Racing accepts no responsibility for equipment hired from the ski centre.

5. Facility Issues

Precise Racing is not responsible for operational issues at the host facility. This includes, but is not limited to, lift failures, slope closures, snow quality issues, equipment malfunction, or any other venue-related disruption.

Where facility issues affect the running of the event, Precise Racing will follow the policies outlined under Section 3 (Cancellations & Curtailment).

6. Changes to Schedule

Event details on our website or printed materials are correct at the time of publication. However, dates, locations, or the event programme may change due to unforeseen circumstances or weather conditions.

We will notify entrants as soon as possible in such cases.

7. Photography & Video

Precise Racing may capture photographs or video footage during events for use in marketing materials including brochures, flyers, social media and our website. Racers will not be named where possible.

If you wish to **opt out**, you must email info@preciseracing.co.uk before the event.

A photographic opt-out form is available on our website or upon request.

8. Child Exclusion

Precise Racing reserves the right to exclude a competitor for reasons such as:

- Dangerous or inappropriate behaviour
- Bullying
- Illness
- Repeated late collection
- Failure to follow instructions

No refunds or compensation will be given if a child is excluded.

9. Data Protection

Precise Racing complies with all applicable UK data protection legislation. All personal information will be treated confidentially and stored securely. Please refer to our Privacy Policy for full details.

10. Agreement to Terms

By entering a Precise Racing event, you confirm that:

- You have read and agree to these Terms & Conditions.
- You understand that skiing is a risk sport and participation is at your own risk.
- You confirm the racer is competent to ski safely and will follow all instructions.
- You accept that Precise Racing is not liable for injuries or accidents except where legally required.
- You understand that suitable personal or school insurance **must** be in place.
